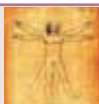

Arrival by Car

Coming from the A5 motorway, change at Autobahnkreuz Heidelberg, coming from the A6 at the Mannheim junction, take the A656 towards Heidelberg. At the end of the motorway, turn left towards Neuenheim/Universitätsklinikum, after about 100 m turn right onto Vangerowstraße, follow the sign for "Unikliniken" and take the Ernst-Walz-Brücke to the north via the Neckar. You are now on Berliner Straße, on the left there is the Campus Neuenheimer Feld. At the first set of traffic lights, at the Jahnstraße tram stop, take the street "Im Neuenheimer Feld", follow the road for approx. 100 m to parking area P 22. Approx. 200 m walk back to the Marsilius College (INF 130).
